Questionnaire

The C-EAS, in both English and German, is the third (and final) in a series of online surveys designed to explore commonalities reported by survivors of extreme abuse. The first survey was for adult survivors of all types of extreme abuse; the second, for persons who have worked professionally with extreme abuse survivors. Provided by S.P.ORG., a non-governmental organization in Germany, this trilogy of anonymous surveys was developed privately by Carol Rutz, Thorsten Becker, Bettina Overkamp, Ph.D. and Wanda Karriker, Ph.D.

The C-EAS is for persons who have served as caregivers for children who have made disclosures consistent with ritual abuse and associated traumatic mind control procedures designed to ensure victims' loyalty to the perpetrator(s) or perpetrator groups.

Definitions:

Caregiver: A person who has provided physical, psychological, medical, spiritual, legal, educational and / or other types of support to at least one child victim of RA / MC who was under 18 at the time the care was given.

Ritual Abuse and Mind Control (RA / MC): There are no widely accepted definitions in the academic or survivor literature for the terms “ritual abuse” and “mind control.” For purposes of this questionnaire the surveyors operationally define “ritual abuse and mind control” using the definition for “ritual violence” proposed by Becker and Froehling:

“Ritual Violence is a severe form of abuse of adults, adolescents and children intended to traumatize the victims.

It consists of physical, sexual and psychological forms of abuse which are planned out and systematically used in ceremonies. These ceremonies may have an ideological background as well as being staged for the purpose of deception and threat. Symbols, activities or rituals which have religious, magical or supernatural connotation are used.

The purpose is to confuse, threaten and terrorize victims as well as indoctrinate them with religious, spiritual or ideological beliefs.

Ritual violence rarely consists of a single episode. Most often these experiences happen over an extended period of time.”

RA includes, but is not limited to, Satanic Ritual Abuse (SRA).

MC refers to all mind control procedures designed to make a victim follow directives of the perpetrator without conscious awareness including, but not limited to, non-consensual mind control experimentation.

The survey should take less than 20 minutes to complete. Some of the questions may be triggering to respondents who are abuse survivors. You may stop at anytime and you do not have to complete the survey.
